



What to expect with pregnancy...

The May Grant providers and staff are here to support you through your pregnancy. These visits are an ideal time to discuss any pregnancy related concerns. Below is a schedule of **routine** prenatal care and what you can expect financially.

FIRST TRIMESTER

Confirmation Visit: (6-8 weeks)

At this visit your pregnancy will be confirmed and a physical exam with pap will be performed, **if due**. Your estimated delivery date will be established and ACOG recommended STD testing will be collected. A prenatal lab panel and 20 min confirmation ultrasound will be scheduled.

Intake Visit/First OB: (10 weeks)

This appointment is the start of your OB care and is 60 min in length. It is comprised of 2 visits. The first part of the visit is with a Nurse Specialist to review your health and pregnancy history as well as provide prenatal education. The second part of the visit is with a provider. You will discuss optional genetic screening to include bloodwork and a 20 minute ultrasound. At the end of the visit, you may hear the baby's heartbeat with a Doppler.

SECOND TRIMESTER

OB Visit 2: 14 Weeks

Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check

Visit is part of the Global Care

OB Visit 3: 18 Weeks

Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check

Visit is part of the Global Care

Fetal Anatomy Scan (45 mins): 20 Weeks

A fetal anatomy scan measuring the baby's head to toe growth and development is completed. Gender can sometimes be determined at this visit.

OB Visit 4: 24 Weeks

Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check

Visit is part of the Global Care

OB Visit 5: 28 Weeks

Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check. A 28 week panel will be completed which includes; CBC, syphilis and 1 hr glucola to test for gestational diabetes. You will also be given the TDAP vaccine. A blood type and screen may be collected and Rhogam injection administered based on your specific blood type. If planning to breast feed, your breast pump will be ordered.

THIRD TRIMESTER

OB Visit 6: 30 Weeks

Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check

Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check

OB Visit 8: 34 Weeks
 Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check → Visit is part of the Global Care

OB Visit 9: 36 Weeks
 Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check. Group B streptococcus (GBS) will also be done which is a test for bacteria that can cause serious infections in newborns. If indicated, you may receive an ultrasound to evaluate growth or position of the baby. → Visit is part of the Global Care

OB Visit 10: 37 Weeks
 Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check → Visit is part of the Global Care

OB Visit 11: 38 Weeks
 Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check. Your provider may check your cervix to assess for dilation as you approach your due date. → Visit is part of the Global Care

OB Visit 12: 39 Weeks
 Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check → Visit is part of the Global Care

OB Visit 13: 40 Weeks
 Routine care with BP, weight check and FHTs check → Visit is part of the Global Care

If your pregnancy goes beyond 40 weeks, you can expect...

OB Visit every 3-4 days:
 If you are still pregnant, you are officially considered to be postdate. The provider may recommend antenatal testing to check on your baby's general well-being. Testing may include a 20 min Amniotic Fluid Index (AFI) ultrasound to measure the amniotic fluid around the baby and a 20 min NST to monitor the baby's heart-rate. Labor induction options may be discussed at this time.
